Make sure that your gymnasts use only FIG certified Hand Apparatus for this event and for any other FIG recognized competitions, as they will not be allowed to compete with an Apparatus which does not comply with the norms.</p> <p>Random checks on the FIG and Manufacturers' Logos will be carried out at any time during the Event.</p>

FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Organizing Member Federation will invite all Member Federations whose gymnasts qualify according to Grand Prix Regulations 2020.						
GRAND PRIX SUPERVISORS	The LOC, according to Grand Prix Regulations, will cover the flight tickets, accommodation, meals and 50 EUR per day including the days of travel for two official Supervisors from the Grand Prix Committee for the period of September 11-14, 2020 (3 nights).						
AGE LIMITS	Senior gymnasts: born in 2004 or before. Only Gymnasts with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License, valid until the end of the event, may participate.						
SIZE OF DELEGATION	<p>The maximum size of a Grand Prix delegation is as follows:</p> <table border="1" data-bbox="662 1019 1257 1131"> <tr> <td>Individual gymnasts</td> <td>1-4*</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Coach</td> <td>1</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Judge</td> <td>1</td> </tr> </table> <p>* National Federations may register to participate as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Individual gymnasts will be invited according to the Grand Prix ranking list after the last 2020 Grand Prix in Brno (RGI): top-12 gymnasts of each apparatus final (nominative invitations). 2) 2020 Grand Prix organizing Federations may register 2 individual gymnasts. 3) Host country Ukraine may register 4 individual gymnasts. 4) Medal winners of the All-Around competition of the Olympic Games, the last World Championships or the last European Championships have the right to participate additionally. 5) Other Federations may register 1 individual gymnast (the best national gymnast). <p>The LOC will cover the expenses (accommodation, meals, local transportation) for 45 gymnasts in total. If the number of registered gymnasts exceeds 45, the LOC will cover the costs for those who registered earlier (except gymnasts from top-12 of the ranking list, granted they have registered before the deadline of the Definitive registration).</p> <p>The LOC will ask to reply to the nominative invitations by the deadline of the Definitive registration. If gymnasts from top-12 of the Grand Prix ranking list do not confirm their participation by this date, the LOC may invite the next eligible gymnasts from the ranking list.</p> <p>Please note that, due to Covid-19 pandemic, the number of participants will be limited.
