Each gymnast may perform 2-4 exercises. Team Competition and Finals (rope, ball, clubs, ribbon) Only 1 gymnast per country may qualify to each apparatus final, +1 gymnast from the organizing country Ukraine.</p> <p><u>Senior groups:</u> All-Around and Finals (5 balls; 3 hoops + 2 pairs of clubs) 8 groups qualify to each final, 1 group per country + 1 group from the organizing country Ukraine.</p>
