The list of the RG Hand Apparatus with valid certificates is published on the FIG website (here) and updated regularly. Make sure that your gymnasts use only FIG certified Hand Apparatus for this event and for any other FIG recognized competitions, as they will not be allowed to compete with an Apparatus which does not comply with the norms. Random checks on the FIG and Manufacturers' Logos will be carried out during the Event.
