JUDGES AND JUDGES' PANELS	<p>Competitions will be evaluated by two Judges' Panels as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 Difficulty (D) Judges (min. cat. 2) • 6 Execution (E) Judges (min. cat. 3) • 2 Line (L) and 1 Time (T) Judges (min. cat. 4) <p>Priority will be given to the highest categories.</p> <p>The Judges' Panels are set up by a draw from the judges present at the event. The draw will be directed by the RG Technical Delegate.</p> <p>The participating member federations must send one qualified judge if they participate with individual gymnasts and one qualified judge if they participate with a group. Those judges can be the same or different.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the online nominative registration, or not sufficient cat. 1 and 2 judges, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the FIG for prior approval of the Technical Delegate the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation.</p> <p>Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation. The results and the updated FIG World Challenge Cup Ranking List will be published on the FIG website within 24 hours after the end of the respective competitions provided that all procedures before and after the competitions are duly respected by the Organizing Member Federation.

Separate World Challenge Cup Ranking Lists for:

- Individual All-Around
- Individual per apparatus
- Group All-Around
- Group Routine

are established for the four World Challenge Cup Series, beginning with the first World Challenge Cup competition of the series and ending with the last World Challenge Cup event of the series (4 competitions).

For the Individual All-Around and Apparatus Ranking Lists, World Challenge Cup Points are assigned to the competitors **by name**.

For the Groups All-Around and Routine Ranking Lists, World Challenge Cup Points are assigned to the **Federation**. The Groups are listed **by Federation** only.

YEARLY WINNER

The yearly winner of the World Cup Series is the gymnast / group with the highest number of points of each of the World Cup Series Ranking List after the last event of the series, counting the best results (maximum 3, **regardless of the number of competitions the gymnast participated in**).

A special award ceremony will be held at the last World Cup Competition of the year in which the winning gymnasts/groups shall receive a Cup.

MEDICAL SERVICES	<p>Medical services in the Venue to be provided by the LOC.</p>
COVID-19	<p>All participants will take a COVID-19 test upon arrival to the official hotels and must stay in their rooms until the results of the tests are ready. During the trainings and competition periods all participants are allowed to circulate only in the assigned sport venues, as well as in the official hotels.</p> <p>Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also recommends all the participants to follow the standard precautions. The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible. The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible, and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout. Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and must keep a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>Additional information will be included in the Work Plan that will be sent to the Federations prior to the event.</p>

DOPING CONTROLS	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will provide at its own charge a minimum of 3 doping controls for Individual gymnasts and 3 for Groups.</p>
MARKETING	<p>FIG advertising and publicity norms must be respected.</p>
TELEVISION	<p>Television coverage is compulsory.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation must guarantee the production of a basic feed (international signal). The International signal must be available for the FIG and its Right holders free of charge at the international Broadcasting Centre or at the Gateway without any limitations and free of any access fees.</p> <p>Host Broadcaster is Match TV. The name of the person in charge of the production will be advised later.</p>
SCORING, RESULT SERVICE AND VIDEO CONTROL	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will provide a scoring and result service, including a high-quality video system which will allow the recording, storage and provision of compilation of the recorded images for the Difficulty Judges, the Superior Jury and the President of the Superior Jury. The videos will be sent to the FIG within one week after the competition. IRCOS will not be available. The name of the video system in use: "Sport Vokrug" Judging System for Rhythmic Gymnastics</p>
