	<p>All senior gymnasts (GC-O 9 and 10) must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event, gymnasts without the FIG licence will be not allowed to start.</p>
<b>JUDGES AND JURIES</b>	<p>It is compulsory that the participating Delegations bring one judge with current FIG brevet. Judges from German clubs need the national A - license</p> <p>The Clubs, Associations or Federations that don't oblige by the established rules relating to the disposability of judges will be penalized with the payment of 30 EURO per participant of the delegation for each missing judge. The non-payment of the penalization will implicate the non-participation in the event of the respective competitors.</p> <p>All the judges indicated by the respective clubs, associations and federations to the organization will have to be present at the respective judges meeting.  Note: Transport, accommodation and meals of each delegation judges are in responsibility of respective delegation.</p>
<b>REGISTRATION DEADLINES</b>	<p>The nominative registration must be made exclusively online via the GymCity Open website <a href="http://www.gymcity-open.de">www.gymcity-open.de</a>. It is possible to register from the 20<sup>th</sup> of February 2022. All members of the delegation that attend the competition (athletes, coaches, judges) have to be registered.</p> <p>Nominative registration <b>20<sup>th</sup> March 2022</b></p> <p>Penalty for missing judge or late registration <b>30€ per Person</b></p> <p>All additional services such as accommodation, banquet and transfer service can be booked by the nominative registration. All coming delegation will be informed through an email.</p>
<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<p>The entry fee for this event will be <b>30€</b> per person.  Entry fees are non-refundable in case of cancellation.</p>
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>The accreditation is on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2022 at 16pm in the local organisation office. Heads of the delegations are required to bring the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Passport/any ID of all members of the delegation</li> <li>- Proof of total payments</li> <li>- Proof of medical insurances</li> <li>- International/national judge licenses</li> </ul>
<b>EVENT FORMAT</b>	<p>Eight (8) finalists (6 finalists if 7 – 8 participants, 4 finalists if 5 – 6 participants, 3 finalists if 3 – 4 participants in category). Finals will start from zero. Tie-breaking rules as per FIG Code of Points.</p> <p>In addition, the host Club SC Cottbus Turnen e.V. is allowed to set up one gymnast per category in every final. If there is no athlete from home club in the final there will be nine (9) starters in the final (Wildcard).</p> <p>In competition there will be no “one- touch” instead every category becomes 20 minutes of warming up.</p>
