 - Best 8 gymnasts for each apparatus will qualify for the finals. Only 1 gymnast per country for each apparatus can qualify for the finals. Host country can qualify with 2 gymnasts. If the host country didn't qualified in first 8, gymnast with best ranking in that apparatus will be added as 9th gymnast.



- ✓ Apparatus Finals
 - RGI Senior Teams can consist of 2-4 gymnasts and total 8 exercises. A Team's score will be sum of 2 hoop, 2 ball, 2 clubs and 2 ribbon score. It is allowed to have more than 1 team but only the best team of a country will be included to the team ranking.
 - All-Around score will be sum of gymnast's hoop, ball, clubs and ribbon score (4 apparatus). If a gymnast performs less than 4 apparatus she can qualify for apparatus finals in those apparatus, but not included to all around ranking. It is allowed to apply with unlimited number of gymnast but only the best 2 gymnasts per country can be included to All-Around ranking.
 - Best 8 gymnasts for each apparatus will qualify for the finals. Only 1 gymnast per country for each apparatus can qualify for the finals. Host country can qualify with 2 gymnasts. If the host country didn't qualified in first 8, gymnast with best ranking in that apparatus will be added as 9th gymnast.

 - All-Around score will be sum of group's 2 exercises scores. If a group performs less than 2 exercises, group can qualify for apparatus finals in that apparatus, but not included to all around ranking.  - Best 8 group for each apparatus will qualify for the finals. Only 1 group per country for each apparatus can qualify for the finals. If the host country didn't qualified in first 8, group with best ranking in that apparatus will be added as 9th group.

VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Turkish Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Turkey. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before January 7th, 2025 to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.</p> <p>NOTE: In case of any medical services in the hospital, the cost must be covered by the delegation.</p>
SAFEGUARDING	<p>From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.</p> <p>The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.</p> <p>In addition, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. Travel Schedule Form must be sent by February 7th, 2025.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The LOC will provide local transportation for all participants (from/to İstanbul International Airport (IST) or Sabiha Gökçen Airport (SAW)) as well as from/to the hotel and Competition Hall.</p> <p>Transfers and transportations will only be available to those who book accommodation directly through the LOC.</p>
